Summer break is just around the corner, which means that it's almost time for Ararat Bible Camp 2016. We are excited about what the Lord will do at the youth camp this year. We have a great line up of preachers and singers, fun activities, challenging games, and an all-around spiritually developmental week planned.

Camp this year will be held again at the Georgia Pinelands Campground (Georgia Sheriff's Association camp facilities) the week of July 11-16, 2016. We will arrive and complete on-site registration on Monday morning from 8:00 – 10:00 AM. If you are not able to arrive during this time period, prior arrangements must be made with the camp director, Bro. Alan Kirk, or his designee. We will pack up and leave the camp facility Saturday morning July 16, 2016.

The registration fee this year is \$100.00 for campers and non-working adults for the whole week. This price includes three prepared meals per day, activities, lodging, and one (1) camp T-shirt per camper. This fee is due to Antioch Baptist Church no later than June 26, 2016. Any camper not registered and paid by June 26, 2016 will be required to pay a \$25.00 late registration fee. In addition to camp meals, there will be a canteen available to campers to purchase items (sodas, candy, and snacks) after the evening service. **Please be sure that all campers have cash available for this time.** (We are praying that the Lord will send in the money needed to have camp this year, and it won't cost any camper anything, but as of now the registration fee is \$100)

We are excited about the preaching line up this year. Bro. John Dorsey, Bro. Rick Hildebrand, and Bro. Bud Stiltner will be with us for the entire week. There will also be preachers called from the floor during the services.

The theme for the camp this year is "Forever Changed" Our theme verse will be II Cor. 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

Please make plans for your young people to attend camp this year. We are looking for big things from the Lord. For the 2015 camp, we will be having a combined junior and teen camp. The ages are 10-18 this year. There will be junior campers on campus, but please assure your teenagers that the juniors will have separate housing (as available) and separate activities within reason.
